Extra cost of giving a presentation is DKK 4,250.

Transport to and from Miedzyzdroje is individual and on own cost. It is possible to fly via Szczecin or to go by car (approx. 6 hours from Copenhagen or Kolding).

#### ABOUT DISTRICT HEATING FORUM

The District Heating Forum in Miedzyzdroje is the largest event of the heating sector in Poland, and is attended by representatives of all major heating companies operating in Poland. The Forum has been organized by Polish Chamber of District Heating for the past 20 years in Miedzyzdroje near Szczecin. This year is the 21 anniversary edition.

The Forum consist of seminars and debates in parallel with a district heating exhibition, where companies can present their technological solutions and services. In 2016 the number of participants amounted to more than 550 people representing the district heating sector. Forum event is an opportunity to exchange views and look at the current situation in district heating.

"Day of New Technologies" is dedicated to the latest technological solutions already operating in the industry and visions and forecasts related to future technologies.

During the Miedzyzdroje Forum a District Heating Laurel is handed over by Polish Chamber of District Heating in number of categories including heat sales.

The main topic of the seminar during Miedzyzdroje Forum 2016 was "Role of district heating in building city of the future". The panelists for the discussion were representatives of Ministry of Infrastructure and the Ministry of Environment. Danish side was represented by Birger Lauersen – Vice President of EuroHeat & Power.
