Currently, CHPP-2 is the most efficient and advanced combined-cycle power plant in the Baltics. Two combined-cycle gas turbine units and five water boilers are operated at the plant. In Jelgava, a district heating operator and provides heating to – households, public buildings, industry. The balance of renewables in heat production in Jelgava is 92%.

	<p>In Daugavpils, GREN provides heat to the city’s district heating operator, securing around 40 % of the heat energy necessary for the city.</p> <p>In Riga, the produced heat energy is transferred to the district heating system of the city of Riga. Electricity production is mainly from renewables – biomass and wind, and a small portion from natural gas.
